### Dear Northeast Friends,


The Christmas season is upon us again, the time for reflecting on another year, spending time with family and friends, and giving some thought to the bigger picture of life -- the Abundant Life.

## Northeast Friendship Ministry helps special needs boy carry Operation Christmas Child boxes

For anyone who has attended the Northeast services where we collect Operation Christmas Child boxes, you know that when the doors open and our own kids bring in the boxes filled with gifts for kids in desperate situations throughout the world . . . it's an awesome sight to witness. Most people will admit they get a little emotional seeing their own child carrying a box that will soon be in the hands of a needy child thousands of miles away.

One family received an extra blessing this year. Sharon and John Survance have a special needs son named Drew, who is autistic. For years they had hoped he would be able to walk down the aisle with the rest of the kids and add to the collection of boxes at the front of the auditorium. Because of his illness, Drew is especially afraid of high ceilings and could not bear to walk into "big church." His parents cried and prayed that someday he would be able to participate.

Thanks to Tracey and Christine of Northeast's Friendship Ministry which reaches out to and serves special needs children, Drew was able to carry down his first shoebox with Tracey and Christine on either side of him. On seeing Drew, his mom literally jumped to her feet and held both arms up over her head and sobbed. Drew saw her and ran to her for a hug. He said "Mommy's crying!" Sharon told him they were happy tears. He wanted to carry another one. And so he did.

Thank you to each person who filled a box for a child and brought it to Northeast. Over 3,000 boxes were collected!
