Connect Ministry Director—Leadership Support

Role Summary: This position is vital to the church and Connect Ministry because it fulfills God's calling in Ephesians 4:12-13 to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church so that they may be mature and full-grown in the Lord.

S.H.A.P.E. desired (Spiritual gifts, Heart, Abilities, Personality, Experiences):

S= Shepherding, Leadership

H= Community, Leadership Support and Growth

A= Team and individual leadership, investing into others, communicating, big-picture thinking

P= Any

E= Participation in a Life Group

The Win: Well-supported Life Group Leaders who are leading healthy Life Groups that are fulfilling Christ's Commission.

Responsibilities:

- Invest relationally into Affinity and other Team Leaders, encouraging them, spurring them on, serving them, praying for them, honoring them, etc.
- Work in partnership with Connect Minister to develop a creative, ongoing process and strategies to care for, support, recognize, and appreciate current Life Group Leaders
- Help Connect Minister discover and deploy new team leaders as needed
- Act as a conduit between Affinity Team Leaders and Connect Minister to carry out Life Group vision and mission through them and their leaders
- Work with Connect Minister to utilize a combination of leadership events, retreats, web site, email, etc. to support current leaders
- Work with the rest of the Life Group Ministry Team to advance a Life Group (community) culture at NECC
- Work with Connect Minister to establish annual goals and a budget to carry out leadership support in the Life Group ministry
