

Connection Groups & Events Team Leader



Role Summary

The Connection Groups & Events Team Leader leads a team that develops social “spaces” which help people develop “neighborly” connections in which they can find friends and a Life Group to join.

The Win: People at Northeast engage socially, find friends, and call Northeast their “home”; they connect into a Life Group where they are discipled and live the Abundant Life.

Responsibilities:

- Team with Connecting Team to develop a culture where people can make friends and gain a sense of “belonging” at Northeast
- Help build a culture where people can form their own Connection Groups & Events around an interest, passion, etc.
- Support Connection Groups & Events leaders and teams as they plan, organize, and carry out their groups and events
- Take strategic advantage of church-wide or other ministries’ planned events to help connect people socially and help them connect with a Life Group
- Creatively and strategically promote Connection Groups & Events through NECCWired, web site, Connect Booth, side screens, etc.
- Follow-up with Connection Group & Event attendees to help them take a next step, especially connecting into a Life Group (i.e., assure Life Groups are mentioned as a next step at group or event and work with Connection Coordinator team member to make follow up calls)
- Work with rest of Connecting Team and Connect Minister to build teams in affinity, interest, and geographic areas to plan regularly occurring Connection Events and launch new Connection Groups
