# unleash building update



- The permitting process with Metro Government is moving forward. We received unanimous support from the Planning and Development Board in mid-December, final construction drawings will now be produced.
- Visioneering, our architects, and Wehr Constructors our construction company, are both doing a phenomenal job and we feel very blessed to have two such high quality companies working hard for us.
- We are grateful to have worked out an arrangement with Billy and Gardner Chamberlain, long time members of Northeast, to buy their property that adjoins the church property, at a point in the future. This will help us fulfill our vision for this campus and so we truly want to thank them!
- As we begin to talk to banks, they will be looking at not only our **unleash** pledges and collections but our general fund giving that will support the mortgage payment we will have. Our general fund giving recently rebounded and **unleash** giving is still on track - we have collected over \$2.3mm dollars toward our \$10.0 pledged total, with total giving now up 40% over last year - that is truly a blessing!
- We are aware that the economy could impact our ability to get the size loan needed to complete the entire first two phases of the project, as we had originally planned. As a result we may need to phase our project differently and slightly delay ground breaking until we can secure adequate funding. We will continue to monitor these situations and keep you updated on our progress.
- We continue to trust God and know He is in control, and we ask for your continued prayers for wisdom and direction in our decision making regarding the building program.

## SERVE AT CHURCH:

With a new year comes a renewed commitment to serving. As we prepare for a growing congregation with our new 2,000 seat auditorium, we welcome you to find out where you can serve. Listed here you will find several opportunities to not only serve but to connect with others. These opportunities are open to **anyone**.

## SERVING OUR YOUTH:

**High School - Snack Booth** - Sell food, drinks and t-shirts before service begins. Clean snack booth after service.

**High School Set Up/Tear Down** - Transform the auditorium into a comfortable atmosphere for students. This requires setting up curtains, putting up banners, putting down rugs, etc. Since it has gone up it must come down.

**Elementary Room Volunteer** - Help us welcome and hang-out with students in Club Jr or the Club during one of our three weekend services.

**Elementary Project Organizers** - This opportunity ranges from helping get curriculum ready, making phone calls, getting letters prepared or other office type work. All can be done during the week and from home or the church office.

**Early Childhood Greeter** - Greet families as they enter the children's area. Help check-in new families and take them to the appropriate class.

**Early Childhood Set-Up Team** - Set up rooms for weekend services.

**Early Childhood Room Volunteer** - Monitor the children as they play during check-in and sit with them during quiet time, encouraging them to listen quietly. Assist the lead teacher with completion of classroom tasks.

**Early Childhood Special Events Team** - Participate with a team that plans, organizes and executes 2-3 events per year, including Father/Daughter Tea, Mother/Son event and Walk through Jerusalem.
