unleash update

We are now six months into our **unleash** campaign and want to update you on where we are with the \$10,000,000 that was pledged in January. As you can see below, 722 pledges were made and as of August 31 - 1,880,000 has been received. Of that total, 161,000 has been given by those who did not originally pledge. Yeah God!



Time wise we are currently 16.70% into our **unleash** campaign and as of August 31, 18.88%

building progress

- Louisville Water Company approved our Worship Center Location relative to the 6' water main under "Main Street." If you recall, this was a major prayer request during our Prayer Walk.
- Visioneering has completed design development drawings and submitted to various sub-contractors.
- Acoustic Dimension was selected as audio/video/lighting design company for our project.
- Kerr-Grulich ws selected as the mechanical contractor and is currently designing the heating and cooling systems.
- Sign and and color themes have been selected for parking, pedestrian ways and new buildings
- Land Design & Development is addressing: specific building location, parking log design relative to code, water runoff and detention, and landscape variances.
- The worship center rock soundings were complete with a favorable minimum depth-to-rock of 12.5'.
- Clifton Campus "spruce up" will be complete October, 2008
- Projected groundbreaking – March, 2009!

MEET LORI & ROBBY WHEELER

Adopting a child was something my husband Robby and I had always talked about doing one day. We thought we would have one or two biological children and adopt our youngest child. But after dealing with fertility issues, miscarriages, and a stillborn child, we felt God leading us to adopt sooner than we had planned.

It amazes me how clearly God’s hand was in our son Cohen’s adoption. After we were matched with Cohen, we prayed about the possibility of visiting him in Guatemala as we waited for his adoption to be finalized. The same week we booked our \$1300 airfare tickets, we received a check in the mail for \$1300 because we had unknowingly overpaid our taxes the previous year.

Months later when I thought I was at my breaking point and could not wait any longer, I prayed that God would please make a way for me to stay with Cohen

until his adoption was complete. Days later we received an anonymous letter along with \$2000 cash – allowing me to live in Guatemala with Cohen for the remaining two months before we were able to bring him home.

Two weeks after I arrived in Guatemala, Robby joined me for six more weeks. God used that time to not only allow us to bond together as a family, but to soak up the Guatemalan culture. We look forward to telling Cohen all the many things we came to love about his birth country and will forever be changed by the things we experienced there.

We saw the hopeless, blank stares of orphans turn into smiles and laughter as we took them out of the orphanage for a walk in the park. We saw kids with disabilities experience independence for the first time as they received their first wheelchair and were no longer confined to a bed. We realized that is wasn’t so difficult



for us to make a life-changing difference for someone else. And we were equally blessed through these experiences!

A year has passed since we were in Guatemala, but our hearts are still there. We are currently planning our first mission trip for March of 2009 where we will be building houses for families with children with special needs and spending time with children living in orphanages. This is our story. This is our passion.
