


Mark 12:13-17

Then they sent to Him some Pharisees and some Herodians to trap Him in what He said. 


- Jesus has reached the last week of His life.

- The Romans stood ready to "keep the peace."







- The Roman soldiers are ready to stomp out revolution.


The USA has a democratic form of government. - This means it derives its ultimate authority from the consent of its citizens who participate through free and fair elections. What do we give to government vs God? 22

- We are not a direct democracy, we are a constitutional republic.




- The legislative makes the law.
- The executive executes and enforces the law.
- The judicial interprets the law.
- Each branch is designed to limit the authority of others through checks and balances.



Federalism is prescribed by the 10th amendment of the Constitution, ratified as part of the Bill of Rights in 1791, which states that "the powers not delegated to the US by the Constitution, nor prohibited by the states, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the people."










"The claim that Jesus makes is that now Christians are part of a global community not embodied in any one government, nation, or place. Exodus 19 said, 'You'll be a special nation.' But now there are no special nations, there are Christians who are special in every nation. This saves us from civic idolatry....We are exiles. We are dual citizens at best. There is no Mecca for us in the world."


"Matthew 28 tells us it's our job to disciple nations, not to set-up a Christian one. At Pentecost you see the movement of Jesus going international. And ultimately the vision of the end of scripture is that every nation, tribe, and tongue will bow and worship before Jesus. So in our cultural moment where an idealized American past is making a claim among some religious groups that we should take it back for God, we should resist this with humility and get on with the business of making disciples of Jesus."

















- 1. Government should get our respect and submission.

- b. While there is no biblically mandated system AND every system is inevitably flawed by our sin, all systems are NOT created equal.


Scripture says Government should facilitate:

- 4. Prosperity 5. Safety

- 2. God gets our ultimate respect and submission.

- geographical borders
- cultural, racial, ethnic barriers
- corrupt governmental action with truth, goodness, and justice.
