Because of the miraculous signs Jesus did in Jerusalem at the Passover celebration, many began to trust in Him. But Jesus didn't trust them, because He knew all about people. No one needed to tell Him about human nature, for He knew what was in each person's heart.

There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee. After dark one evening, he came to speak with Jesus. "Rabbi," he said, "we all know that God has sent You to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with You." Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God."

John 2:23-3:21

"What do You mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?"

Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. Humans can reproduce only human life, but the Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life. So don't be surprised when I say, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it wants. Just as you can hear the wind but can't tell where it comes from or where it is going, so you can't explain how people are born of the Spirit." "How are these things possible?" Nicodemus asked. Jesus replied, "You are a respected Jewish teacher, and yet you don't understand these things?

I assure you, we tell you what we know and have seen, and yet you won't believe our testimony. But if you don't believe Me when I tell you about earthly things, how can you possibly believe if I tell you about heavenly things? No one has ever gone to heaven and returned. But the Son of Man has come down from heaven. And as Moses lifted up the bronze snake on a pole in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in Him will have eternal life.

JOHN 2:23-3:2 - STATEMENT ABOUT HUMAN NATURE

Human nature is not theocentric, it's egocentric.

Our primary interest is self-interest.

JOHN 2:23-3:2 - STATEMENT ABOUT HUMAN NATURE

Jesus to Nicodemus

- "you cannot see the Kingdom of God."
- "You are a respected Jewish teacher, and yet you don't understand these things?"
- "you won't believe our testimony."
- "anyone who does not believe in [Me] has already been judged"
- "people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil"
- "All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed."

JOHN 2:25

Doctrine of Adoption

Doctrine of Regeneration

An instantaneous, metaphysical, inner change to the very essence of your soul that cures the sickness of sin and launches a life-long process of healing.

Doctrine of Sanctification
The life long process of healing for those who have been regenerated - "Re-Regeneration"

Struggling with a life-dominating sin:

- Admit I have a struggle I cannot overcome without God.
- Acknowledge the breadth and impact of my sin.
- Understand the origin, motive, and history of my sin.
- Repent to God for how my sin replaced and misrepresented him.
- Confess to those affected for harm done, and seek to make amends.
- Restructure my life to rely on God's grace and his Word to transform my life.
- Implement the new structure with humility and flexibility.
- Persevere in the new life and identity to which God has called me.
- Steward all of my life for God's glory.

If you want to find peace in an anxious world, you must choose confession over concealment.

JOHN 3:19-21
