- What does this passage teach us about obedience? How should it affect the way I live?

### As a Group

It can be amazing to see the strides humanity makes from time to time in the fields of education, technology, medicine and science and be fooled into believing that human progress is capable of eliminating all human problems.

So how do we hold a realistic view of the human condition? We will all die, we are all capable of great acts of love and evil, and we all want ultimate justice.

How does what you read today reconcile with the human condition?

The last part of the Matthew passage we read today is called The Great Commission. Have you ever thought that your primary purpose on this earth is helping others to know Jesus?

How would you describe a "disciple".

What are some tangible ways to do this in everyday life. Don't think "I need to go on a mission trip across the world." Rather how could you do this when you go to the grocery this week?

A simple definition of a disciple could be someone who is simply following Jesus, being changed by Jesus and is committed to the mission of Jesus.

Does this simplify our task, or complicate it? Discuss how.
